It was noted that work has commenced on planning application 18/0587 prior to permission being granted, Clerk to notify Barbara Percival (planning officer). Clerk also to reiterate the PC's request to have a site visit.

### 112/18 Clerk and Chairman Report

- Dalston War Memorial has been awarded listed building status. List Entry Number: 1458513.
- Cumdivock War Memorial has also been awarded listed building status. List Entry Number 1457978.
- Cumbria County Council have approved the Parish Councils application (CA13/18) to correct nonregistration of land at Forge Green. Thanks were given to Tim Cartmell for assisting the PC with this application and a donation of £100 was given to the Northern Fell Group.
- A building survey is to be carried out on Forge Green on 18<sup>th</sup> September by David Edmundson.
- 3 leaning blown trees close to Bridge End are to be cleared by Lowther tree surgeons for a cost of £700.
- Cumbria In Bloom Award Ceremony to be held at the Coronation Hall, Ulverston on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> September 2018, 1.15pm – 3.45pm. Cllr Byers and Pat Jackson to attend.
- St Michael's Church archeological investigation began on the 11<sup>th</sup> September 2018.
- RFO to attend a Cumbria CVS funding event on the 4<sup>th</sup> October.

### 113/18 Correspondence

• A response letter from Gareth Scott (Highway Network Manager) was circulated to the Councillors prior to the meeting. He stated that the work in and around the square has been held up due to discussions with Story Homes regarding junction improvements to Station Road / Carlisle Road and until this is resolved any work in the Square is unlikely.

He also stated that the land outside the Cumberland Building Society is not registered as highways, therefore this area would be maintainable under public expense. Cllr Roberts spoke regarding the application submitted in 2012 to register the unfenced land on The Green as common land. It was reported that in the past Carlisle City Council have resurfaced the area outside the public toilets and sub station. Clerk to look for any correspondence relating to this.

It was also noted that a drain opposite the Co-op needs unblocked. Clerk to report.

Cumbria County Council are prepared to undertake work over a period of time to increase the area of hardened verges along the Green. However he asked the Parish Council to indicate their value of funding towards this project and stated that if both parties agree a third party agreement would need to be set up in order for funds to be transferred.

- A copy of Carlisle City Council's Electoral review was circulated to Councillors prior to the meeting. They currently consist of 52 Councillors however they propose to reduce this to 39 Councillors in the future, representing 13 three-Councillor wards across the Council area; meaning the boundaries of all wards would change. The Parish Council chose not to comment.
- It was reported that there had been an incident regarding two cyclists on the Dalston cycle path resulting in one casualty been taken to hospital. Signage along the track is incorrect as one side says keep left whilst the other side says keep right therefore if cyclists are coming from both directions they will collide head on. Clerk has reported this to the Countryside Access Team (Better Highways).
- Correspondence has been received regarding the speed tractors travel through the village. Clerk to respond.
- Councillors were notified of a vacancy on the CALC Executive Committee.

- St Michael's School have written to parents regarding parking around the school. There have been a number of incidents where people have parked inconsiderately posing a risk to pupils, other parents and local residents. Advice has been sought from the police and there will be an increased presence around the school and anyone found to be in breach of parking regulations may be fined.
- Correspondence has been received regarding vegetation on the path between the Station and Nestle. The PC have given permission for David Gibson (Countryside Access Officer) to spray the weeds annually along the path. Clerk has also logged a request to Network Rail to cut the hedges.

### 18/114 Housing Needs Survey

A synopsis of last month's discussion on the Housing Need Survey was circulated to Councillors prior to the meeting. After discussion it was resolved to complete a new survey if and when there is a need to do so.

## 18/115 Glave Hill Car Park

A valuation report from Carigiet Cowen on behalf of the Trustees of the Victory Hall was circulated to the Councillors prior to the meeting. After much discussion Cllr Craig proposed that the Parish Council should explore the offer to purchase the car park further. Cllr Roberts seconded this and all Councillors present were in favour. Further information and clarification to be obtained before the next meeting along with a site visit by the P&M committee. It was decided that the next PC meeting on the 9<sup>th</sup> October should be held in the Victory Hall and parishioners be invited to comment on the purchase of the car park.

- The P&M meeting has been moved from the 18<sup>th</sup> September 26<sup>th</sup> September 2018 and will be held in Church House at 7pm.
- Agenda items to include the flag pole relocation a site visit to Glave Hill car park and the building survey report. A letter is to be written to Keith Potter thanking him for maintaining the flag pole.

### 18/117 Tillhill Tree Report

• A copy of the tree report was circulated prior to the meeting. All the recommended tree works are to be completed. Clerk to contact Tilhill regarding insufficient information on a number of the trees.

### 18/118 11th November 2018 – 100 Years Of Remembrance

Following the Armistice Service in the Church on the 11<sup>th</sup> November there will be a Tattie Pot lunch in the Victory Hall. Places are limited and it will be first come first served, with a charge of £5 for a two course lunch and a drink. In the evening there will be a Beacon and other events which will be confirmed in the November Parish Paper.

- Cllr Baxter suggested each month small items of information regarding the recent traffic counts are printed in the Parish Paper.
- Cllr Dinning informed the Council that due to recent insurance claims the Recreation Association will be unable to host the annual bonfire evening.
- Cllr Kyle requested the recent Raughton traffic count be put onto the October PC agenda.
- Cllr Roberts asked for an update on purchasing an amplifier system. RFO getting quotes.
- Cllr Dinning kindly offered to take the old gas fire to Bousteads Grassing.
