1. Apologies

6. Common Land Nook Lane / Lakerigg

- Resolved - to discuss options to prevent the land at Nook Lane being cut without permission at the next Parish Council meeting on the 13th July.
- Resolved - not to place an information board on the common land at Nook Lane.
- Clerk to ask Clarke Davidson to clean the beck running through the common land at Nook Lane.
- It was agreed the vegetation on the left side of the Nook Lane common land (near the second gate as you drive towards Cumdivock) be cut back in September. Clerk to liaise with Lindsay Cowen prior to the work commencing.
- Resolved - the common land at Lakerigg be left as it is. It was also agreed that a cutting protocol for the area is not required.

7. Cemetery Walk

- Clerk to obtain a price to pollard the leylandii tree located by the Lytch gate in St Michaels church.
- The wooden gate in the cemetery is to be repaired as it doesn't shut properly.

8. Village Seats

- Resolved - to remove the vandalised seat which is located by the riverbank on The Green.
- Resolved - to repair and make good the seat at Smithfield. It is also to be raised on concrete blocks.

9. Millennium Garden

Resolved – to repair the Millennium Garden gate. Cllr Byers to inform Stewart Hudson that his request for the fence to be straightened was declined.

10. Mitchel Brow

Resolved - the two front Oak trees located at Mitchell Brow be felled, this will provide the required space for the other Oak trees to grow. The Oak tree to the right of the area is to be crown lifted. Clerk to arrange.
