Application and use of these Risk Assessments.

Dalston Parish Council recognises that effective health and safety management can contribute towards organisational performance by reducing injuries, ill health, unnecessary losses and liabilities.

To this end we abide by our duties and responsibilities under the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 including all associated future enactments and will seek to create and maintain a positive health and safety culture.

The following Risk Assessments have been provided to assist the Parish Council in making sure that it has identified any Health and Safety risks concerning their assets and have taken the necessary control measures to mitigate these risks.

Each Risk Assessment identifies foreseeable hazards and rates the risk presented by the hazard using a matrix of - Severity X Likelihood.

Death	5	Almost Always
