

Dalston Co-op



One of our flagship projects began as an idea in 2017. In 2018 we took steps to make this happen. It became a community renovation of the well worn waste area in front of the Dalston Co-op. While the work was carried out by Westwood Landscapes, it was funded by community donation. The 'before' and 'after' pictures speak for themselves. This is phase 1 of a 2 phase project.

In 2019 the project community continued to renovate the other half of the worn area in front of the Dalston Co-op, to match the garden area we completed in 2018. While again the work was carried out by Westwood Landscapes, it was funded by many community donations from both individuals and local businesses. A trodden area of grass was also turfed. A group of children have helped us with the collection of stones which have been used in the project to surround the area. These river stones have been used in gardens and properties over the years and a wall, recognised as part of Dalston heritage has been rebuilt by Story Homes adjacent to the Townhead Road entrance to the new housing estate. A path was made between the two developments.
