

CUMBERLAND COUNCIL (FOOTPATH NO. 114005 IN THE PARISH OF DALSTON)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS) ORDER 2023

WHEREAS the Cumberland Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) being the traffic authority for Footpath No. 114005 in the Parish of Dalston is satisfied that pedestrian traffic in the said road (footpath) should be restricted by reason the likelihood of danger to the public due to a damaged bridge and to allow repairs to be carried out (“the Works”).

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf hereby make the following Order.

1. No person shall proceed along that section of Footpath No.114005 in the Parish of Dalston, from its junction with U2048 near Bellgate, extending in a north easterly direction to its junction with U1135 near Cardew Hall.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply other than at such times and to such extent as is indicated by the appropriate traffic signs.
3. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty fifth day of May 2023 and may be cited as Cumberland Council (Footpath No.114005 in the Parish of Dalston) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrians) Order 2023.
