

CUMBERLAND COUNCIL (FOOTPATH NO. 114040 IN THE PARISH OF DALSTON)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the above Order (“the Order”) made by Cumberland Council on 21 October 2025, which became operative on 31 October 2025, because of the likelihood of danger to the public, due to ongoing riverbank erosion and to enable subsequent repair works to be carried out (“the Works”) and which would otherwise expire on 30 April 2026

**:has been continued in force with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport until 30 April 2027.**

The effect of the Order is to prohibit pedestrians from proceeding along the entire length of Public Footpath No. 114040 in the Parish of Dalston.

There is no suitable alternative route available for pedestrians.
